A Bill Providing Assistance to the Automobile Industry

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE STUDENT CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED THAT:

2 **SECTION 1.** The Secretary of the Treasury shall allocate loans of \$25 billion to automobile manufacturers
3 and component suppliers that have--

4 **A.** Submitted an application for a loan that includes a statement of need for funding to
5 prevent a systemic adverse effect on the US economy;

6 **B.** Operated a manufacturing facility for the purposes of producing automobiles or
7 automobile components in the United States throughout the 20-year period ending on the
8 date of enactment of this title; and

9 **SECTION 2.** The Treasury Secretary shall prioritize distribution of loans based on the magnitude of the
10 impact of the manufacturing operations of the applicant in the United States on the overall
11 economy of the United States and other segments of the automobile industry, including the
12 impact on levels of employment, domestic manufacturing of automobiles and automobile
13 components, and dealerships.

14 **SECTION 3.** At the time of application for a loan, an automobile manufacturer or component supplier
15 shall submit to the Secretary a detailed plan on how the Government funds requested will be
16 utilized to ensure the long-term financial viability of the company, and how such funds will
17 stimulate automobile production in the United States and improve the capacity of the
18 company to pursue the timely and aggressive production of energy-efficient advanced
19 technology vehicles.

20 **SECTION 4.** This act shall become law three days following passage, and the Secretary must determine
21 eligibility of each applicant within 15 days of receipt of the application, and must disperse
22 funds within 7 days.

23 **SECTION 5.** The term to maturity of any loan made shall be 10 years, or such longer period as the
24 Secretary may determine with respect to such loan. The interest rate shall be 5 percent during
25 the 5-year period beginning on the date on which the Secretary disburses the loan; and 9
26 percent after the end of that period.

A Bill to Commission Private Security Contractors to Protect Shipping Interests en Route to the United States

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE STUDENT CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED THAT:

2 **SECTION 1.** The President of the United States is authorized and requested to
3 commission, under officially issued letters of marque and reprisal, so
4 many of privately armed and equipped persons and entities as, in his
5 judgment, the service may require, with suitable instructions to the leaders
6 thereof, to employ all means reasonably necessary to protect and defend
7 outside the geographic boundaries of the United States and its territories
8 the property of United States business interests from piratical aggressions
9 and depredations perpetrated upon the property of citizens of the United
10 States of America.

11 **SECTION 2.** No letter of marque and reprisal shall be issued by the President under this
12 Act without requiring the posting of a security bond in such amount as the
13 President shall determine is sufficient to ensure that the letter be executed
14 according to the terms and conditions thereof.
